The Town Board of the Town of Long Lake, Washburn County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and orders as follows:

A public hearing to discuss a proposed action to discontinue a public way in the Town of Long Lake shall be held as provided in accordance with the following Notice of Hearing.

The town clerk shall publish the following Notice of Hearing as a class 3 notice under chapter 985, Wis. stats., and the town clerk shall cause the Notice of Hearing to be served on the owners of all of the frontage of lots and lands abutting upon the public way sought to be discontinued in the manner provided for the service of summons in circuit court at least 30 days before the hearing, except that when service cannot be made within the town, a copy of the notice shall be mailed to the owner's last-known address at least 30 days before the hearing:




That part of Fairy Lane Lying South of the Southerly Edge of Midway, as shown on the Plat of Alvern, Washburn County, Wisconsin.


The town clerk shall file in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Washburn County, Wisconsin, a lis pendens related to the proposed discontinuance of public way.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
